2021 RESIDENTIAL SANITATION AND RECYCLING SCHEDULE

Suburban Carting is closed for the following holidays: (please refer to the "if a holiday occurs on..." columns below)
Fri 1/1/21, Mon 1/18/21, Mon 2/15/21, Mon 5/31/21, Mon 7/5/21, Mon 9/6/21, Mon 10/11/21, Thurs 11/25/21, Fri 12/24/21, Fri 12/31/21

- > Bulk trash must not exceed 3 square yards per week (example: 8 standard kitchen trash bags)
- > Construction, remodeling, and demolition debris will not be allowed or collected. This includes lumber, sheetrock, roofing material, cabinets, tile, toilets, hot water heaters, windows, sinks, doors, concrete, asphalt (generally, materials related to renovations/work by a contractor).
- > Brush will be picked up Thurs or Fri: it must be tied, bundled and is not to exceed 2 piles sized at: 4ft by 4ft.
- Leaf pick up (excluding fall leaf collection dates) must be in paper bags and placed curbside for Thursday or Friday pick up. Plastic bags may not be used. The use of gas-powered leaf blowers is prohibited in the Town of Ossining between May 31 and September 30 every year.
- Fall leaf collection will begin on or about October 19, 2021 and go through December (weather permitting). Leaves should be placed loose curbside (except for State Routes 133 & 134, where leaves must be bagged [in paper bags only, no plastic]).
- Waste oil disposal: Accepted at the Highway Dept. 85 Old Rte.100, Briarcliff Manor, from 7:30 am 3:00 pm Monday-Friday.
